- 4. Life Orientation
- 5. Choose any three subjects from the following list: Business Studies, Computer Applications Technology Physical Sciences, Life Sciences, Consumer Studies, History, Visual Arts, Tourism, Music, Dramatic Arts, Design, Geography, Accounting, Engineering and Graphic Design, Information technology

Recommended for students outside South Africa but intending to study at a South African university. Students select from the following list of subjects:
